Institut za međunarodne studije, Fakultet društvenih nauka (Charles University) u Pragu dostavio je informaciju o novim magistarskim studijskim programima, i to:

Balkanske, euroazijske i srednjeeuropске studije (**BECES**) je program koji nudi studentima dvije specijalizacije: 1) Ruske i Evroazijske studije i 2) Balkanske i Europske studije duboko i svestrano istraživanje „Istoka“, shvaćenog kao teritorije koja se sastoji od srednje Europe, balkanskog poluotoka, područja bivšeg Sovjeta uključujući Kavkaz i središnju Aziju.

Navedeni program usredotočen je na savremenu povijest, politiku i diplomaciju, kao i na temljene društvene, kulturne i ekonomski probleme izabranog područja. Studentima se također nudi prilika da nauče ili poboljšaju svoje znanje o odabranom regionalnom jeziku (npr. češki, njemački, ruski, poljski itd.).

Master iz područja studija (**MAS**) je interdisciplinarni program koji nudi studentima tri specijalizacije: 1) globaliziranje američkih studija, 2) integracijske studije i 3) tranzicijske studije stručna znanja i analitičko-sintetičke vještine usmjerene na savremenu povijest i kvanitativni razvoj današnjeg svijeta.

Evropska politika i društvo (**EPS**) je multidisciplinarni dvogodišnji zajednički magistarski program koji povezuje područja europske politike, savremene povijesti i kulture, međunarodnih odnosa i kreiranja politika

Naprijed navedeni programi otvoreni su za studente sa diplomom u relevantnom području i koji ispunjavaju zadane kriterije. Komisija za prijem će ocjenjivati prijave na osnovu dostavljenih dokumenata i bodova (1-100) u sljedećim kategorijama: akademska pozadina, motivacija, vannastavne aktivnosti. Granicu bodovanja za prihvatanje kandidata određuje dekan Fakulteta društvenih nauka Čarlsovog univerziteta.

Godišnja školarina za studente koji počinju u akademskoj 2019/2020 godini određena je u iznosu od 3.000 EUR za studente iz EU/EEA i u iznosu od 6.000 EUR za studente izvan EU/EEA.

Krajnji rok za podnošenje prijava je **30. april 2019. godine.**

Balkan, Eurasian and Central European Studies (BECES)

The programme offers the students with its two specializations 1) *Russian and Eurasian Studies* and 2) *Balkan and Central European Studies* a deep and versatile exploration of "the East", understood as a territory composed of Central Europe, the Balkan Peninsula, and the Post-Soviet area, including the Caucasus and Central Asia. BECES focuses on modern history, politics and diplomacy, as well as on fundamental social, cultural and economic problems of the chosen area. It also offers students the chance to learn or improve their knowledge of chosen regional language (e.g. Czech, German, Russian, Polish etc...). BECES is deliberately structured to take advantage of the multidisciplinary nature of the Faculty, and students will be encouraged to make connections between different fields of study, learning to combine a global perspective with attention to detail and local interests.

After Studies

After completion of BECES, the graduates will have acquired an advanced level of graduate education including a good command of one or two of the languages of the area as well as a broad and deep knowledge of the region studied. They will have the opportunity to continue their self-education and to find positions related to the issues in the studied area in both the public and private spheres.

Admissions

BECES is open to students holding a Bachelor degree in the relevant subject area who fulfil selected criteria. The admissions committee will assess the applications on the basis of submitted documents and award points (1-100) in the following categories: academic background, motivation, extra-curricular activities. The point limit for accepting applicants is set by the Dean of the Faculty of Social Sciences of Charles University.

DEADLINE for applications is 30th April 2019.

Tuition fees

Annual tuition fees for students commencing in the academic year 2019/2020 are set at 3 000 EUR for EU/EEA students and at 6 000 for non-EU/non-EEA student.

Master in Area Studies (MAS)

This interdisciplinary programme offers the students with its three specialized tracks 1) *Globalizing US Studies*, 2) *Integration Studies* and 3) *Transition Studies* expert knowledge and analytical-synthetic skills focused on modern history and current developments of today's world. MAS provides the students with tools for social science analysis and allows them to build their own thematic and territorial profile according to their individual needs and future career plans.

After Studies

After completion of MAS, the graduates will be endowed with internationally recognizable multi-disciplinary training in the study of international affairs. They will be able to analyze individual topics arising within the region of their interest from a multidisciplinary point of view in terms of social and modern history.

The graduates will have the opportunity to continue their self-education and become highly-skilled employees in the civil service and diplomacy, NGOs and international institutions as well as in private companies and mass-media. They will be well prepared for a variety of academic pursuits and will possess a wide range of knowledge and skills required in various social science fields.

Admissions

BECES is open to students holding a Bachelor degree in the relevant subject area who fulfil selected criteria. The admissions committee will assess the applications on the basis of submitted documents and award points (1-100) in the following categories: academic background, motivation, extra-curricular activities. The point limit for accepting applicants is set by the Dean of the Faculty of Social Sciences of Charles University.

EPS { European Politics and Society}

European Politics and Society (EPS) - Václav Havel Joint Master Programme is a multidisciplinary two-year Erasmus Mundus Joint Master Degree Program linking the fields of European politics, contemporary history and culture, economy, international relations and policymaking.

What do we offer?

The key role of the programme is to identify and analyse challenges Europe faces today (migration, security, populism). The first semester of the EPS Programme is based on Master level introductory courses (in Prague), the second semester focuses on EU related courses (Krakow, Leiden). In the third and fourth semesters, the programme offers four different study tracks reflecting the diverse expertise of the Consortium members (Prague, Krakow, Barcelona, and Leiden). Each track combines various elective courses, research methods training, an internship and language tuition with an advanced research dissertation supervised by key staff from each Partner University.

Extra-curricular activities

Two important features of this exclusive programme are an intensive extra-curricular training programme and a direct link to the future work field through frequent interaction with professionals and experts from outside academia through the Associate Partners of the EPS programme.

Joint Events

All students spent their first semester in Prague, where they participate in the Prague Introductory week. At the end of the first semester, they choose the topic of the Master thesis and write a draft proposal for the thesis project, which they will present at a three-day Barcelona Research Seminar. For the second semester students have two options, go to Leiden or Krakow. The two final semesters can be spent at any of the four universities depending on the specialization.
