## **REGULATIONS**

ON THE RECOGNITION OF FOREIGN HIGHER EDUCATION QUALIFICATIONS FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONTINUING STUDIES AT SLOBOMIR PUNIVERSITY BANJA LUKA AND THE PROCEDURE FOR THE EQUIVALENCE OF PREVIOUSLY ACQUIRED ACADEMIC DEGREES

Pursuant to Article 54, paragraph (4) of the Higher Education Act ("Official Gazette of the Republic of Srpska", Nos. 67/20 and 107/24) and Article 26 of the Statute of SLOBOMIR P University Banja Luka, the University Senate at its 4th session held on 23 September 2025 adopted the

#### REGULATIONS

ON THE RECOGNITION OF FOREIGN HIGHER EDUCATION QUALIFICATIONS FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONTINUING STUDIES AT SLOBOMIR PUNIVERSITY BANJA LUKA AND THE PROCEDURE FOR THE EQUIVALENCE OF PREVIOUSLY ACQUIRED ACADEMIC DEGREES

#### I. GENERAL PROVISIONS

#### Article 1

- (1) These Regulations prescribe procedures and criteria for the recognition of foreign educational qualifications for the purpose of continuing studies at SLOBOMIR P University in Banja Luka (hereinafter: the University).
- (2) The Regulations further regulate the procedure and manner of determining the equivalence of degrees previously awarded by the University under earlier regulations with the new degrees conferred in accordance with the Higher Education Act, the Statute and other general acts of the University.
- (3) The provisions of these Regulations apply to the recognition of foreign educational qualifications and, by analogy, to the recognition of domestic qualifications obtained through formal, non-formal and other forms of education and learning.

- (1) For unified interpretation, the terms used in these Regulations shall have the following meanings:
  - Academic recognition of a foreign educational qualification means the formal confirmation of the level of education attained, and of the applicant's acquired knowledge, skills and competencies, for the purpose of access to further studies.

- Equivalence is the procedure by which a degree obtained at the University under regulations not based on the European Credit Transfer and Accumulation System (ECTS) is aligned with the new degrees obtained in accordance with ECTS-based study rules.
- Higher education diploma is an official document certifying the completion of higher education.
- Diploma supplement is an official document forming an integral part of the higher education diploma, containing a description of the nature, level, context, content and status of the studies completed by its holder.
- Foreign higher education qualification is any official document issued by a foreign higher education institution, except documents obtained on the territory of the former SFRY until 6 April 1992 and official documents and certificates under the Agreement on mutual recognition of documents in education and regulation of status issues of pupils and students ("Official Gazette of the Republic of Srpska", No. 79/05) obtained at accredited higher education institutions in the Republic of Serbia.
- (2) Terms used in the masculine or feminine form in these Regulations shall be understood to include both genders.

- (1) The University's organizational units, i.e. the competent Commissions, are obliged to apply the provisions of these Regulations.
- (2) The Commissions are expert bodies of the organizational units appointed by the Rector upon proposal of the relevant academic or artistic-academic council, with a mandate of one year, for the purpose of implementing the procedure regulated by these Regulations.
- (3) The decision establishing a Commission pursuant to paragraph (2) shall determine the number, composition and mandate of the Commission members and other matters relevant to the work of the Commission.

II. PROCEDURE AND CONDITIONS FOR THE RECOGNITION OF HIGHER EDUCATION QUALIFICATIONS OBTAINED AT FOREIGN HIGHER EDUCATION INSTITUTIONS FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONTINUING EDUCATION AT THE UNIVERSITY

- (1) The recognition procedure is initiated on the basis of a prior submitted application by a person who wishes to continue their education at the University. The Application Form is an integral part of these Regulations.
- (2) Persons who have obtained a higher education credential at another higher education institution (domestic and/or foreign) are entitled to recognition.
- (3) The competent body for the procedure under paragraph (1) is the faculty or organizational unit that is the applicant's home unit for the relevant field at the time of application.
- (4) In the recognition procedure, other principles and rules shall be applied in accordance with the Council of Europe/UNESCO Convention on the Recognition of Qualifications concerning Higher Education in the European Region ("Official Gazette of BiH", No. 16/03 International Treaties) and its accompanying documents, UNESCO's Recommendation on the Recognition of Studies and Qualifications in Higher Education (27th Session, Paris, 13 November 1993), UNESCO Guidelines on the recognition, validation and accreditation of the outcomes of non-formal and informal learning, the Revised Standards and Guidelines for Quality Assurance in the European Higher Education Area (Conference of Ministers responsible for Higher Education in the European Higher Education Area, Yerevan, May 2015) and other domestic and international regulations in the field of higher education.

- (1) Persons who obtained a higher education credential at another higher education institution (domestic and/or foreign) have the right to recognition.
- (2) The following documents must be submitted with an application for recognition of a foreign educational qualification:
  - the higher education credential, in original or certified copy, or other proof of completed education or of acquired knowledge, skills and competencies;
  - the diploma supplement;
  - transcript of records and achieved ECTS credits issued by the higher education institution, if the institution does not issue a diploma supplement;
  - transcript of records if the credential was obtained in a country that does not use the ECTS;
  - the official study curriculum/program in original or downloaded from the institution's website, or its summary with a link to the source, which must correspond to the curriculum under which the applicant studied;
  - birth certificate extract;
  - copy of identity document proving citizenship (passport for foreign applicants);
  - document proving change of name and/or surname;

- final thesis, if required for the qualification, in original, certified copy or electronic format;
- a consent statement by the applicant authorizing verification of information on the obtained education;
- proof of payment of the procedure fee.
- (3) If any document from paragraph (2) is not drawn up in one of the official languages used in Bosnia and Herzegovina, a certified translation must be provided.
- (4) If the application is incomplete or unclear, the applicant shall be granted a maximum of 30 days to supplement or clarify it.
- (5) If the applicant fails to supplement or clarify within the given period, the application shall be rejected by decision.
- (6) A special appeal against that decision is permitted.

- (1) In the academic recognition procedure, the Commission may verify the authenticity of the credential or the information on the acquired education.
- (2) The Commission may verify authenticity directly or through other competent institutions (relevant ministry, Centre for Information and Recognition of Foreign Higher Education Qualifications in the Republic of Srpska, etc.).

- (1) Upon receipt of the application, the competent Commission shall examine the submitted documentation and other information obtained in cooperation with competent authorities, to determine whether conditions for conducting the procedure for continuation of studies at the University are met.
- (2) The Commission shall prepare a Report on the application containing a proposal for recognition/equivalence. The Report Form is an integral part of these Regulations.
- (3) In preparing the Report, the Commission shall examine official documentation and otherwise establish relevant facts.
- (4) The Report shall contain applicant data, details of the completed study, rationale and proposal for recognition/equivalence of the previously obtained academic degree or diploma.

- (5) Based on the Report and its reasoned proposal, the Dean shall issue a Decision within five days of adoption, determining whether and at which year and cycle of study the student may continue their education, the number of credits recognized, and any additional obligations under conditional recognition.
- (6) The Decision under paragraph (5) shall be accompanied by a certificate of recognized examinations. The Decision Form is an integral part of these Regulations.
- (7) An appeal against the Decision under paragraph (5) may be lodged with the faculty's academic/artistic-academic council within 15 days of receipt of the Decision.
- (8) The Council's decision is final.

- (1) If full recognition of a foreign qualification cannot be granted due to substantial differences, the competent authority shall consider other forms of recognition: conditional, partial and alternative, in accordance with the principles and provisions of the instruments listed in Article 4, paragraph (4) of these Regulations.
- (2) Conditional recognition confirms the applicant's education at the level of the qualification and allows enrolment in the appropriate study programme subject to fulfillment of missing admission requirements during the course of that programme (examination, seminar work, research, internship, etc.).
- (3) Partial recognition covers individual credits or learning outcomes, allowing the applicant to enrol in a lower-level study programme than requested and to have passed examinations or learning outcomes recognized.
- (4) Alternative recognition acknowledges a qualification or learning outcomes at a lower level than required by the applicant, or recognizes the same level but permits enrolment in a programme similar to the one requested.
- (5) If the institution has the necessary capacities, the applicant may be offered special education outside standard programmes to remedy substantial differences that hinder continuation of studies in the requested programme.
- (6) If alternative recognition is not possible, the application shall be rejected.
- (7) A rejection Decision shall state the reasons why recognition cannot be granted and indicate how the applicant may act to enable continuation of studies.

(1) The academic/artistic-academic council of the faculty may, for a person who completed higher vocational education lasting four to six semesters, decide to recognize a specific number of ECTS credits and determine supplementary course requirements or other conditions for continuation of studies to obtain a first-cycle diploma.

#### Article 10

- (1) The right to enrol in the second cycle of studies is granted to a person referred to in Article 9 where the University organises studies under the 3+2 model (180+120 ECTS) having completed at least a three-year programme, or under the 4+1 model (240+60 ECTS) having completed at least a four-year programme.
- (2) If the content of the previously completed programme substantially deviates from the content of current programmes, additional conditions to be met for continuation of studies shall be determined.
- (3) If the additional requirements are of such scope that they prevent regular attendance of second-cycle studies, the faculty may refuse admission to the second cycle and direct the applicant to enrol in the first cycle.

# III. EQUIVALENCE OF PREVIOUSLY ACQUIRED DEGREES WITH NEW DEGREES

- (1) Persons who obtained degrees at the University under previous regulations have the right to request equivalence of previously obtained degrees with new degrees.
- (2) The equivalence procedure at the University is initiated at the request of the person who previously obtained the degree at the University.
- (3) The competent unit for the procedure under paragraph (1) is the University member that issued the diploma or the member that is the applicant's home unit for the field at the time of application.
- (4) The request shall be submitted on the form attached to these Regulations, which forms an integral part thereof.

A certified photocopy of the diploma and other documents necessary for the decision shall be submitted with the equivalence application.

### **Article 13**

- (1) Upon receipt of the request, the Dean of the unit shall appoint a three-member Commission to conduct the equivalence procedure.
- (2) The Commission shall prepare a report on the request containing a proposal for equivalence. The Report Form is an integral part of these Regulations.
- (3) When proposing a decision, the Commission shall apply statutory provisions and subordinate acts regulating the use and conferment of academic and professional titles.
- (4) The Dean shall issue the Equivalence Decision no later than 60 days from the date of submission of a duly completed request. The Decision Form is an integral part of these Regulations.
- (5) An appeal against the Equivalence Decision may be filed with the academic/artistic-academic council within 15 days of receipt of the Decision.
- (6) The Council's decision is final.

#### Article 14

When proposing a decision on the request, the Commission shall be guided by the following general uniform criteria for equivalence:

- 1. Previously awarded two-year higher vocational qualifications, specialist qualifications obtained after five- or six-year basic programmes, and scientific titles of Master of Science/Arts have no equivalents among the new degrees.
- 2. Previously obtained education after three years of basic studies and a professional, academic or scientific title prescribed by law shall be equated with the new title of graduate (bachelor), with an indication of the relevant field and 180 ECTS credits, in accordance with applicable regulations on degrees obtained upon completion of higher education.
- 3. Previously obtained higher education and a professional, academic or scientific title prescribed by law after four years of basic studies shall be equated with the new title of graduate (bachelor), with an indication of the field and 240 ECTS credits, in accordance with applicable regulations on degrees obtained upon completion of higher education.

- 4. Previously obtained higher education and a professional, academic or scientific title prescribed by law after five years of study shall be equated with the new title of Master, with an indication of the field and 300 ECTS credits.
- 5. Previously awarded specialist professional titles obtained after four-year basic studies and one-year specialist studies shall be equated with the new title MASTER, indicating the relevant field and 300 ECTS credits.

- (1) Information on procedures and criteria for academic recognition of foreign educational qualifications, non-formal education and other forms of education and learning shall be publicly available.
- (2) Recognition procedures are part of the internal quality assurance system and, like other higher education activities, are subject to external evaluation in accordance with applicable rules.

#### Article 16

- (1) The University, i.e. its faculties, shall keep records on the recognition of domestic and foreign higher education credentials. Recognition procedures are part of the internal quality assurance system and, like other higher education activities, are subject to external evaluation in accordance with applicable rules.
- (2) Documentation on the recognition of domestic and foreign higher education credentials shall be permanently kept in the University or faculty archive.

#### IV. TRANSITIONAL AND FINAL PROVISIONS

#### Article 17

- (1) Costs of the procedure regulated by these Regulations shall be borne by the applicant.
- (2) The amount of the fee referred to in paragraph (1) shall be determined by the University Board of Directors by a Decision on tuition and other fees for each academic year.

Recognition procedures initiated before the entry into force of these Regulations shall be completed pursuant to the provisions of previous regulations on academic recognition.

#### Article 19

Upon entry into force of these Regulations, the Regulations on the Recognition of Foreign Higher Education Certificates and Qualifications No. 372/11 of 20 July 2011, with subsequent amendments and supplements, shall cease to apply.

#### Article 20

These Regulations shall enter into force on the eighth day following their publication on the University's website and shall apply from the beginning of the 2025/2026 academic year.
